

School Banking



Once you have opened an account you can send in your child's banking book via the classroom grey bank bag system every **<u>Tuesday</u>**. Please take note of the following:

- 1. Please limit money amounts to \$50 and under.
- 2. If deposits do not match the deposit slip then banking will be returned.
- 3. If deposit slips are not completed then banking will be returned.
