Our new term is certainly now underway with the first signs of winter weather to remind us of the seasonal change to expect in the Mountains at this time of year.


Visiting classrooms and other learning spaces each day is a wonderful reminder of the craft of teaching and the power of learning to inspire the **passion**, and **compassion** of our students.

It is always a delight to witness good learning in action and to see students thinking deeply, engaged and enjoying the challenge of learning. This means that as educators and learners we strive to build a culture that reinforces the belief that through hard work and good strategies the talents and gifts of students can be developed to their full potential. This aptitude is often referred to as a **Growth Mindset**.

Walking through learning spaces during the first fortnight of term and speaking with students about their learning I have been impressed by the strong climate of student engagement and hard work.

A few highlights include:

- Learning Intentions (lesson aim) and success criteria (jointly constructed) and utilised by students as a tool for self-assessment
- Problem solving strategies utilised in various Key Learning Areas including in Numeracy and Coding
- Music and Band lessons where students are actively involved in composing playing and appreciating music
- Students engaged in daily writing for a purpose and audience
- Opportunities for students to reflect on scripture and Catholic values
- High quality literature being enjoyed, shared and used as mentor texts
- Physical Education lessons focused on developing skills, promoting socialisation and team work
- Conversing in and learning about another language and it's culture (Italian)
- Intervention programs in Mathematics and Literacy to support students to achieve growth
- Feed-back as an integral part of learning: teacher to student, student to teacher and student to student.



The knowledge, skills and attitudes we teach need to always be considered within the scope of how they ultimately influence a child's passion and compassion as a young person within a learning community. In visiting classes to **honour** and **celebrate** the wonderful learning taking place I am always in search of signs of that passion and compassion.

Wishing all mothers, grandmothers and mother-figures a blessed and happy day for Sunday.




Diocesan Cross Country
